# Theme Installation

## WordPress Technical Requirements

- for localhost you can use [xampp](#), [wamp](#), vertrigo or any Apache with PHP and MySQL server.
  - [Microsoft IIS](#) with PHP 5.2.4+ and MySQL 5.0+ support.
  - Livesite (preferably a sub-domain for testing) with PHP 5.2.4+ and MySQL 5.0+.
  - For **Manual Theme Installation**, you need a full installation package for WordPress, so [download here](#) and don't forget about [WordPress Server Requirements](#), or you may already have a WordPress powered website.
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## Theme Installation

This refers to installing the theme on your WordPress powered website. This means you already have a website with content items, widgets, various plugins, so you just decided you want to improve the design of your website. So here's what you have to do:

- Unpack all files and folders of the Package file you downloaded from TemplatesCraze and open the **Orangetheme Theme** folder.
  - Copy the **themefiles.zip** file to your desktop for your convenience.
  - Log-in to your WordPress back-end ( <http://www.your-website.com/wp-admin> or <http://localhost/my-website/wp-admin> ).
  - Go to **Appearance** menu in the left sidebar and click **Themes**.
  - Click **Install Themes** tab and then click the **Upload** link just below. This will show a file upload form.
  - Click **Browse** and find the installation file **themefiles.zip** (should be on your desktop as we instructed you just above), click the file when found and then click the **Open** button.
  - Click **Install Now** button. The theme is now installed.
  - Go to **Manage Themes** tab and find the newly installed theme.
  - When found, click the **Activate** link just below it.
  - Go to front-end and check your site.
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## Required Plugins Installation

To get the full working of the theme you'll need to install few required plugins. After successful installation of theme please follow instructions on dashboard to download and activate required plugins.

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## Sample Data Installation

Sample data file has also been included in the package file. Importing **sample data** will help you set your site with ease, you can install the sample data:

- Unpack all files and folders of the Package file you downloaded from TemplateCraze and open the **Sample Data** folder.
- Copy the **demo.xml** file to your desktop for your convenience.
- Log-in to your WordPress back-end ( <http://www.your-website.com/wp-admin> or <http://localhost/my-website/wp-admin> ).
- Go to **Tools** menu in the left sidebar and click **Import**.
- Click **WordPress** and then install the **Wordpress Imported** plugin.
- Once installed go back to **Tools** menu in the left sidebar and click **Import**.
- Click **Browse** and find the **demo.xml** file on your desktop (should be on your desktop as we instructed you just above), click the file when found and then click the **Open** button.
- Click **Upload now and import**. It will take a minute to download the sample images from my demo site, but after that, the sample data is installed.

## What is in Sample Data?


Sample data file contains some demo posts and pages to fill up the site to look great. **The Main Thing** in sample data file is that it selects the **Page Template** for appropriate page and creates the contact form in the 'Contact Form 7' plugin. You may delete the sample posts but be sure to keep page templates assigned.

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# Required Settings

## Setting Default Pages

- Go to **Setting** menu in the left sidebar and click **Reading**.
- Make your reading settings as shown in image below.
- Front Page: **Home**
- Post Page: **Blog**
- And save your changes by clicking button at the end of the page.

## Page Number Settings

- Go to **Setting** menu in the left sidebar and click **Page Numbers**.
- Make your Page Number settings as shown in image below.
- **Uncheck** 'Include theme stylesheet for page numbers' to use stylesheet provided in package file.
- Change default text of '<' '>' With 'Previous' & 'Next' as shown on point **2 & 3** in image or whatever word you like.
- Uncheck 'Show page info' as shown in point 4.
- Update Settings by clicking the button at the end of the page.

## Set Location of Navigation Menu

- Go to **Appearance** menu in the left sidebar and click on **Menus**.
- Click on **Manage Locations** Tab and set location as shown in image below.
- Primary Menu : **Main**
- Footer Menu : **Footer**
- And save your changes by clicking button at the end of the page.

- Logo
  - Logo top margin (to adjust the height of logo if its not centered.)
  - Favicon
  - Tracking Code for Google Analytics
  - Feedburner url (To activate newsletter service)
  - Company's Slogan (which is visible on the opposite side of logo in header.)
  - Footer text
  - Text to display at subscribe us bar
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## Slider

OrangeClock Theme is loaded with two different jQuery sliders to fill your needs. Whichever theme you select it will automatically create new menu option on admin-panel's main sidebar. You can add, delete or edit slides same like regular posts. **Note:** Switching to different slider will not effect the settings and content of the other slider. Both sliders have their own databases.

- **Lean Slider** – Responsive, HTML 5 slider to scroll your images and text with ease with continue reading button.
  - **Nivo Slider** – With some cool transactions Nivo is also an responsive slider which can be used if you wanna slide just images/banner with out content.
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## Homepage Widgets

You can customize the whole look and feel of the homepage by using pre-designed widgets.

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## Contact Page

Contact information to show on contact us page.

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## Color Settings

Whole Color Scheme of OrangeClock can be changed using options available on this page like, Top-bar, Heading Color, Borders, Buttons, Hover Color etc.

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## Portfolio Settings

Portfolio settings can be used to customize the whole look of portfolio page. GreyScale effects, Image popup, number of columns, all can be changed.

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## Blog Settings

A wordpress theme is incomplete without blog section and power of blog is more when you can customize it. This section of theme options allows you to change settings related to blog section like; show/hide side-bar, number of columns to show posts in, show/hide social icon on single post.

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## Social Media

Enhance the power of your website by making it easy for your visitors to share it on social networks. Icons of all major social networks have been packed in theme, just type the URL of particular network to show its icon on your site.
